Reflections by the Executive Director

RP Home's mission to provide quality of care and a supportive living environment is even more pertinent as we are challenged by the pandemic. While we focused on ensuring we institute infection control best practices and adhere to the ever-changing guidelines and regulations related to COVID-19, we continue to strive to support the residents' physical, spiritual, social and emotional well-being during this difficult time.

Despite the effects of the pandemic, we continued to improve our physical environment and programs. We invested in a \$1.1 million HVAC expansion and domestic water boiler replacement. The resident community spa in nursing was renovated to a more homelike environment and the McKee Dining Room was renovated to expand resident seating and provide a fine dining experience.

We have focused for the past year on improving the homelike environment on the McKee Place community. We have increased the amount of activities provided to the residents while providing a diverse selection. The resident dining experience now is similar to eating in a restaurant. Residents select their meal from a menu and are served in courses. Residents are empowered to actively lead resident council and make decisions for their programming.



We are blessed to have the dedicated and compassionate individuals who serve our residents every day. Our employees, volunteers, board members, residents, family and friends are all a part of 2020's success.

We appreciate the generosity of everyone who supports our mission. We look forward to continuing our mission and serving our residents in the spirit of Christian love as taught by our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

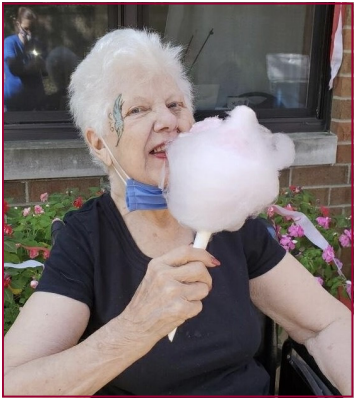

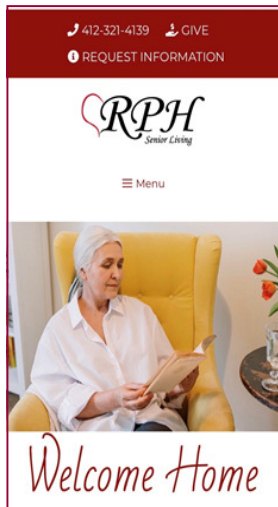


RPWA Annual Association Meeting

Our volunteers adapted to the visitation restrictions and many continued to volunteer remotely and continued to touch the lives of our residents from home! Rev. George Woodruff and Mr. Ed Verbeke provided various spiritual programs using Zoom. Others performed entertainment from outside so that the residents could watch from their windows.

RP Home is continuously building relationships with the community. We have connected with various colleges and universities. Students from Chatham University, Geneva College and University of Pittsburgh have volunteered or completed internships at RP Home.
