REFLECTIONS BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends,

This June marks the Reformed Presbyterian Home's (RP Home's) 128th anniversary. 128 years since our founding, we continue to strive to provide quality care and a supportive living environment to the seniors in our community.

We believe that all older adults deserve safe, high-quality health care that is based on what matters most to them as individuals and delivered reliably in every setting. We meet those care needs and standards by providing four key services: Independent Living, Personal Care, Short-Term Care, and Long-Term Care.

RP Home is also leading the way in making sure that every day, every older adult receives age-friendly health care. We're now part of the Age-Friendly Health Systems movement, an initiative of The John A. Hartford Foundation and the Institute for Healthcare Improvement in partnership with the American Hospital Association and the Catholic Health Association of the United States. This makes us among the first health systems in the country implementing age-friendly health care.

Education Makes This Care Possible

Ongoing staff education ensures that RP Home residents receive the most up-to-date services and care. Most recently, our staff participated in training in three key areas: fall prevention, infection



prevention practices and vaccination programs, and Dementia Training. We thank the RISE Program (Long-Term Care Resiliency, Infrastructure Supports, and Empowerment) for funding these sources, and AMI Expeditionary Healthcare for hosting the training themselves. As we move into 2025, we look forward to scheduling more staff training programs.

Updates and Upgrades Around the Home

In 2024, we completed our Chapel and Resident Community Room renovation! We hosted a dedication and donor recognition ceremony on November 2nd to mark the end of this incredible campaign. We are grateful to the many donors, foundations, and governmental grants that helped the RP Home fundraise \$470,306 to renovate the Chapel and Community Room!

Renovations have also wrapped up on hallway improvements that will benefit those in our Personal Care nursing community. We chose to work on this project because having a homelike environment improves a resident's well-being; it promotes comfort, dignity, and overall higher quality of life. Thus, improvements to our Home and hallways improve our resident's mood and mental health, improving their transition into our home! Residents and staff have expressed their gratitude for the individual donors, foundations and federal grants which made these renovations possible.

Planning for the Spring and Beyond

Providing a supportive social and spiritual environment is fundamental to our mission. We have many programs to look forward to in 2025 such as a Genevans choir performance, Volunteer

Appreciation Week, National Nursing Care Week, and the Walker Celebration of Lights Event. We hope you'll join us at the Home for these lovely events and celebrations!

A LIFE OF GENEROSITY REMEMBERING CAROLYN METCALFE MOLLENKOP

We are grateful for the many faithful donors who support the Reformed Presbyterian Home. Today, we'd like to share the story of Carolyn Metcalfe Mollenkopf, a dedicated giver who also blessed the RP Home with an estate gift.

Born and raised in New York, Carolyn grew up in the Reformed Presbyterian denomination, which sponsors the RP Home. She remained deeply aware of the Home's mission and always took an interest in its welfare.

After graduating from high school in Chappaqua, NY, Carolyn attended Geneva College, earning her degree in 1962. She spent her early career teaching before raising her two sons, then dedicated 32 years to serving Baltimore County Public Schools as a librarian. In that role, she supported thousands of school employees and nurtured a deep love for children and learning. She often shared joyful stories from her time as a librarian.

For 24 years, Carolyn also worked weekends and summers as a concierge at the Hyatt Regency in Baltimore. Board member David Weir once heard from a friend who stayed at the Hyatt and praised Carolyn for her warmth and attention to detail. She made guests feel welcome, helped them navigate the city, and even shared insider tips about the hotel, turning their visit into a special experience. Carolyn loved meeting famous guests and often had hilarious stories to tell.



In 2008, Carolyn reconnected with her alma mater, Geneva College, in a meaningful way. She developed a close friendship with board member Louise Copeland during a trip to Cyprus with New Song, the group Louise directed. Carolyn became an enthusiastic supporter, traveling with New Song and the Genevans choirs on their national and international tours. She also served on Geneva's Alumni Council and helped organize sporting events in her area.

A true people person, Carolyn never met a stranger. She formed deep connections with people of all ages, especially college students and the elderly. She devoted herself to caring for her parents as they lived well into their nineties and frequently visited the RP Home, showing her commitment to its mission. We are incredibly grateful that she chose to include the Home in her estate plan.

Carolyn loved giving gifts—both large and small. She contributed generously to organizations like the RP Home and delighted in handing out \$2 bills like candy. In many ways, she was like a \$2 bill herself—uncommon, surprising, and invaluable.
